

DAY AND NIGHT

Discuss with your class what they can see in the sky during the day. They will possibly mention airplanes, birds, clouds, sun etc.

Ask them if they can see airplanes, birds, clouds, sun etc during the night. Some may mention that airplanes can be seen and ask why.

Ask the children what is in the sky at night? They will mention stars, moon etc. See if they can find out how night differs from day.

Find out if the sun can be seen in the sky at night. What about the moon in the day? If the moon is in the sky (and well away from the sun) take the children out to look at it.

Ask your class to draw their house as it would look during the day. Suggest that they draw what they see around their house and maybe the students doing something they enjoy.

Now ask them to draw their house as it would look at night. How does it differ? What can you see?
